Take the difficult assignment

Exodus 3:10 (NIV84)

¹⁰ So now, go. I am sending you to Pharaoh to bring my people the Israelites out of Egypt.”

Opt for higher expectations

Jeremiah 12:5 (NIV84)

⁵ If you have raced with men on foot and they have worn you out, how can you compete with horses? If you stumble in safe country, how will you manage in the thickets by the Jordan?

Understand humility and strength

1 Peter 5:5–7 (NIV84) ⁵ Young men, in the same way be submissive to those who are older. All of you, clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, because, “God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble.”

⁶ Humble yourselves, therefore, under God’s mighty hand, that he may lift you up in due time. ⁷ Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you.

Go further

Matthew 5:41 (NIV84) ⁴¹ If someone forces you to go one mile, go with him two miles.

Hold on in the storm

Acts 27:22 (NIV84)

²² But now I urge you to keep up your courage, because not one of you will be lost; only the ship will be destroyed.

Educate then articulate

Luke 2:52 (NIV84) ⁵² And Jesus grew in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men.

Hebrews 5:8 (NIV84) ⁸ Although he was a son, he learned obedience from what he suffered

Raise up people

Luke 4:16 (NIV84)

¹⁶ He went to Nazareth, where he had been brought up, and on the Sabbath day he went into the synagogue, as was his custom. And he stood up to read.

Luke 24:53 (NIV84)

⁵³ And they stayed continually at the temple, praising God.
