Take the difficult assignment

Exodus 3:10 (NIV84)

¹⁰ So now, go. I am sending you to Pharaoh to bring my people the Israelites out of Egypt."

Opt for higher expectations

Jeremiah 12:5 (NIV84)

5"If you have raced with men on foot and they have worn you out, how can you compete with horses? If you stumble in safe country, how will you manage in the thickets by the Jordan?

Understand humility and strength

1 Peter 5:5–7 (NIV84) ⁵Young men, in the same way be submissive to those who are older. All of you, clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, because, "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble." ⁶Humble yourselves, therefore, under God's mighty hand, that he may lift you up in due time. ⁷Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you.

Go further

Matthew 5:41 (NIV84) 41If someone forces you to go one mile, go with him two miles.

Hold on in the storm

Acts 27:22 (NIV84)

²²But now I urge you to keep up your courage, because not one of you will be lost; only the ship will be destroyed.

Luke 4:16 (NIV84)
